# **Getting To The Event**



Participants are responsible for their own travel arrangements to and from the event.

#### Allow plenty of time to get there:

## **Public transport**

If travelling by public transport, plan ahead and check for planned closures / engineering works.

Stratford is connected by the Underground Central and Jubilee lines, the overground train and the DLR. The nearest mainline station is Stratford / Stratford International.

## By bike

The venue is close to Sustrans National Cycle Network Route 1 and Cycle Superhighway CS2.

## By car

<u>From the North</u>: Follow the M25 clockwise to junction 27 for the M11. Exit for A12 to Eastway / A106. From the A106 take the exit signposted A12 and follow Waterden Road as per the signs to Stratford International's car park.

<u>From the East</u>: From the North Circular (A406) exit for A12 to Eastway / A106. From the A106 take the exit signposted A12 and follow Waterden Road as per the signs to Stratford International's car park.

<u>From the South</u>: Follow the M25 anti-clockwise to junction 31 for the A13, North Circular (A406). Exit for the North Circular (A406) and A12. Exit the A406 for A12 to Eastway / A106. From the A106 take the exit signposted A12 and follow Waterden Road as per the signs to Stratford International's car park.

<u>From the West</u>: From the A11 turn left onto Vallance Road / B108. Continue on the B108 after around 3 miles take Hackney Road / A1208, A107, A106 and A12 to Waterden Road. Follow Waterden Road as per the signs to Stratford International's car park.

## **Parking**

**No parking is available on site** – the nearest car park is at Stratford International, a three minute cycle ride away.
